Jefferson County Courthouse

Port Townsend

The courthouse, finished in 1892 with the addition of the clock tower, features brick from St. Louis and sandstone from Alaska. In 1912, before the building had electrical power, winding the clock took several hours. Thanks to electricity and an elevator; it now takes 15 minutes.



Suzzallo Library

University of Washington

Named for Henry Suzzallo, the fifteenth University of Washington president, the library was designed by the same architects who planned the Seattle campus. The reading room inside features leaded-glass windows and a vaulted ceiling that peaks at 65 feet high.



Tacoma

The Tacoma Dome's story is best told in numbers. Just a few: the roof alone weighs more than 1.4 million pounds. The concrete used in the venue's construction would stretch into a sidewalk 70 miles long. The stadium contains over nine miles of aluminum cable and about 2.5 miles of welding.

Seattle

The lighthouse began operating in 1881 to guide boats traveling between Elliott Bay and Shilshole Bay. Now, the lighthouse is part of Discovery Park, Seattle's largest park. On a clear day, lighthouse visitors can also catch a glimpse of Mount Rainier.

Museum of Pop Culture

Seattle

When designing the building, architect Frank Gehry had to accommodate the nearby Seattle Center Monorail, operating since 1962, so the train runs through the building. Originally opened as the Experience Music Project in 2000, the facility reinvented itself as the Museum of Pop Culture in 2016.

Cathedral of St. John

Spokane

The first bishop of Spokane set the foundation stone in place in June 1928. A member of the Episcopal church's congregation designed the cathedral, which houses three chapels, one for each of the three congregations that united to form the parish: St. Peter's, St. James' and All Saints.

Meeker Mansion

Puyallup

The mansion began as the family home for Ezra and Eliza Meeker, who came to the Northwest from Ohio, by way of the Oregon Trail. Some people believe the building — now home to tours, weddings and other events — is haunted and claim to have smelled Eliza's perfume or seen Ezra's ghost.

Stadium High School

Tacoma

The building was originally intended as a hotel, but an 1893 economic crisis halted construction, and an 1898 fire left only the walls standing. The school district bought the remains of the building in 1904, finished construction and opened the high school two years later.

Bavarian Buildings

Leavenworth
